Purpose

This document is a living document that is monitored regularly and adjusted accordingly as the agency evolves, as survivor and community needs change, or systems issues are revealed.

Outreach and systems advocacy are a vital component in the movement to support survivors and end violence within our communities. This plan establishes a method of doing so that is owned by all Hope Shores Alliance staff.

Supervisors, coordinators and all agency leaders are ultimately responsible for the implementation and actions of this plan. This plan will remain active by leadership prioritizing its implementation at one-in-one supervision sessions as well as larger team meetings.

Outreach Goals: 2022-2023

Agency outreach goals have been determined and divided into three tiers by leadership. Tier 1 community partners are highest priority. Efforts focus primarily on Tier 1 objectives. Objectives will be measurable to give a realistic perspective of progress and improvement areas. Outreach work is ongoing, dynamic, and often develops organically throughout the course of service delivery. Progress updates will be noted for all community partners as they are reported, regardless of tier.

Tier 1: Law enforcement agencies, emergency shelter providers, Alpena Community College, media outlets

Tier 2: K-12 schools, child advocacy centers, prosecutor's offices, courthouses, Housing Assessment Resource Agency (NEMCSA), animal shelters, animal control, Catholic Human Services Substance Use ERT, hospitals, Michigan Works!, county jails, senior citizen service providers

Tier 3: Legal Aid/public defenders, probation/parole, DHHS CPS, substance use support services, mental health support programs, general homeless shelters, TSA and other transportation providers, health centers, faith communities
